Recognized Program Equivalencies

The indicated areas of study under *Program Deficiencies* must be appended to the *Accredited Entity's* diploma or certificate in order to fulfill the requirements of equivalency. To establish equivalency either a certificate or diploma must be presented along with an official transcript verifying the certificate or diploma's authenticity
